

## 3-6 Cross Country Information

Dear Parents/Carers,

The 3-6 Cross Country Carnival (and Year 2 children turning 8-optional) will be held at Mount Terry Public School on Friday 20th May. The carnival will be split with children turning 8, 9 and 10 (mostly Year 3 and 4 children with a small number of children in Year 2 turning 8 who have completed the permission note and some children in Year 5 who are turning 10) will attend the morning session and then return to class. The children turning 11 and 12 (Year 5 and 6) will attend/participate after recess.

**Information:** Children are to wear their sport uniform or sport colours and will be required to bring a water bottle, towel, plastic bag and a change of socks. Recess and lunch will occur close to normal times.

**Spectator information:** We are happy to announce that spectators can attend the carnival but will be encouraged to watch their child run and then depart the venue. This is to assist with limited seating. To assist with the running of the carnival, could all spectators please enter/exit the school via the main gate on the Terry Street entrance, so that there will be limited crossing of the track.

**Signing out your child:** If you would like to sign your child out early, please sign next to your child's name on the class roll at the sign-out table near the Year 6 tables next to the playground.

**Wet Ground:** The ground is still currently wet due to the amount of rain we have received over the last couple of weeks. With more wet weather forecast, a camp chair/seat or blanket is recommended to be brought from home to sit on.

**Distance:** 8/9 and 10 year old children will be running 2km  
11 and 12/13 year old children will be running 3km
